CLAIM FORM FOR SETTLEMENT WITH DEFENDANTS

If you believe you qualify as a member of the Settlement Class, as defined below, you must submit a timely and valid Settlement Claim Form (“Claim Form”) by first-class mail postmarked by **February 13, 2017**, to the address below, for you to receive any payment as a result of the Settlement with Defendants McWane, Inc. and its unincorporated divisions, AB&I Foundry and Tyler Pipe Company (together, “McWane”), Charlotte Pipe and Foundry Company and Randolph Holding Company, LLC (together, “Charlotte Pipe”) and the Cast Iron Soil Pipe Institute, (collectively, “Defendants”) in the lawsuit *In re Cast Iron Soil Pipe and Fittings Antitrust Litigation*.

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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This Claim Form relates to the proposed settlement with the Defendants in *In re Cast Iron Soil Pipe and Fittings Antitrust Litigation*, No. 1:14-md-2508-HSM-CHS, pending in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee.

“Cast Iron Soil Pipe and Fittings,” or “CISP,” as those terms are used in the Settlement Agreement, are items, manufactured predominantly from cast iron, that are primarily used in residential, commercial, industrial and government buildings for sanitary and storm drain, waste, and vent piping applications.

The Settlement has a Settlement Class defined as: All persons or entities that purchased CISP in the United States directly from any of the Defendants, their subsidiaries, predecessors, or affiliates, from November 1, 2006, through December 31, 2013 (the “Settlement Class Period”). Excluded from the Settlement Class are certain companies that have already settled their claims against Defendants or which have otherwise agreed to exclude themselves from the Settlement, the Defendants, their parent companies, subsidiaries, predecessors, and affiliates, federal and state governmental entities and instrumentalities of federal or state governments, and any Settlement Class Member who timely and validly elects to be excluded from this Settlement Class.

Please fill out this form completely and accurately. Do not file a claim if you are an indirect purchaser, as defined below.

Please also note there are specialized companies that may offer to fill out and file your claim in return for a percentage of the value of your claim. The Court has not authorized any of these companies to contact you. Before you sign a contract with one of these companies, you should examine the claim filing process provided in the accompanying Notice and decide whether using a specialized company is worth the cost. You can always seek help from the Claims Administrator or Settlement Class Counsel without charge.
